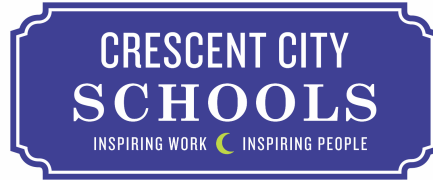


Student Fee Policy

Crescent City Schools believes in offering an excellent education to all students. It further believes that the inability to pay student fees should not prevent students from having access to a quality education, and that economically disadvantaged students and students whose families are experiencing economic hardships should have the same opportunities afforded to them as to other students.

The following is a list of student fees. All fees are collected in the school’s main office and may be paid in cash, with a money order or certified check, or with a debit card. The organization may also offer an online portal for payment of fees. Collected fees are used to defray the costs of the referenced supply, activity, or experience.

Families who would like to request an economic hardship waiver of a fee may do so by alerting the front office and speaking with the school's social worker or their designee. Waiver requests will be approved or denied based on a family's demonstrated financial need. Waiver requests that are denied may be appealed to the school principal.

No student will ever be denied a uniform, technology, or participation in a field trip or activity because of a lack of ability to pay a fee. Nor will students be denied any other academic opportunity because of a lack of ability to pay a fee. Furthermore, failure to pay any required fee shall not result in the withholding of a student's educational record. No fees not authorized by this policy shall be assessed.
